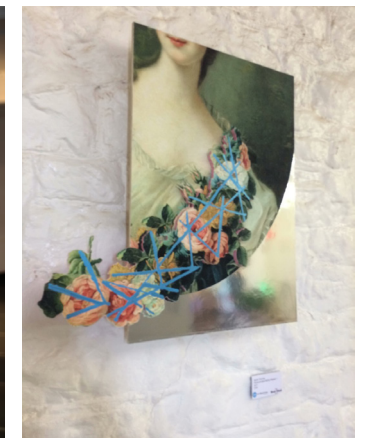
Calling all local businesses and artists who want to collaborate on a bit of fun for #AWExeter 2018.
